Approach

Clonlara School's approach to education is guided by a unique philosophy. Each Clonlara student pursues a personalized education which is developed through collaboration between a Clonlara advisor or teacher, the student, parents, and/or a mentor. Curriculum materials and experiences are selected based upon the goals, learning strengths, and interests of each individual student. Our global learning community links our campus and off-campus students through a variety of opportunities including clubs, workshops, events, in-person meet-ups, pen pals, and discussion forums.

Our Graduates

Clonlara graduates go on to colleges and universities as well as entrepreneurial, athletic, artistic, military, and a host of other careers. Each individual diploma represents a student's particular preparation to reach those goals. Because each student follows a unique plan, we do not offer a class ranking or make statistical comparisons between or among our students. Clonlara does not identify core courses as Advanced or Accelerated unless they were earned and so designated at another institution.

Endorsement

Students can earn the following endorsements: Arts (students complete at least 7 Arts credits), Computer Science (students complete at least 7 Computer Science credits), STEM (students complete at least 13 STEM credits), and Global Studies (students complete at least 9 credits that have an international focus, including at least 3 credits of a foreign language). Endorsement courses are indicated on the transcript using the + symbol in front of each course title. Students earning an endorsement are also required to complete a capstone project focused on the area of endorsement.

Capstone

In grade 12, all students complete a capstone project in a subject area of interest. Projects can be cross-curricular and must include a portfolio.

21st Century Competencies

We ask all our students to consider not only **content** in their courses, but also **communication**, **collaboration**, **critical thinking**, **creative innovation**, and **confidence**. Our students and their mentors evaluate progress in each of the 6 Cs throughout the student's educational journey. Transcript Information

Clonlara School students can choose to work on an academic year schedule or a calendar year schedule.

Academic Year: Semester information: Clonlara School academic year students earn credit from September 1 through August 31. On the transcript, the "Sem" column indicates the semester. "Sem 1" indicates the period from September through January; "Sem 2" indicates the period from January through June; and "SU" indicates the period from June through August.

Calendar Year: Semester information: Clonlara School calendar year students earn credit from February 1 through January 31. On the transcript, the "Sem" column indicates the semester. "Sem 1" indicates the period from February through June; "Sem 2" indicates the period from June through November; and "SU" indicates the period from November through January.

Previous School Information: Previous school names appear at the end of the transcript in order of student attendance. Transferred courses appear with one or more * symbols. One * symbol indicates that the credit was earned from the first school on the list, two * symbols indicate credit earned from the second school on the list, and so forth. The letter grade issued by the school will be listed on the Clonlara transcript; however, it will not be calculated in the Clonlara GPA.

Recognition

Clonlara School is recognized by the United States government and holds federal nonprofit, tax-exempt educational institution status [501(c)(3)]. Clonlara School is recognized by the State of Michigan Department of Education (MDE) as a private school. It is also recognized by the State of Michigan as a nonprofit, tax-exempt educational institution. Private schools in Michigan are in compliance with MDE regulations by (in part) completing and filing a "Nonpublic School Membership Report" form (Form SM 4325) with the Department at the start of each school year. Clonlara School Graduation Requirements

Graduation requirements include a 22-credit minimum, a capstone project, a portfolio of best work, at least 180 hours of volunteer service, an exit exam, and a reading list.

Clonlara credit is awarded on the basis of time, like the Carnegie Unit. While the Carnegie Unit considers 120 hours equal to one credit, Clonlara requires 180 hours of study to earn one credit.
